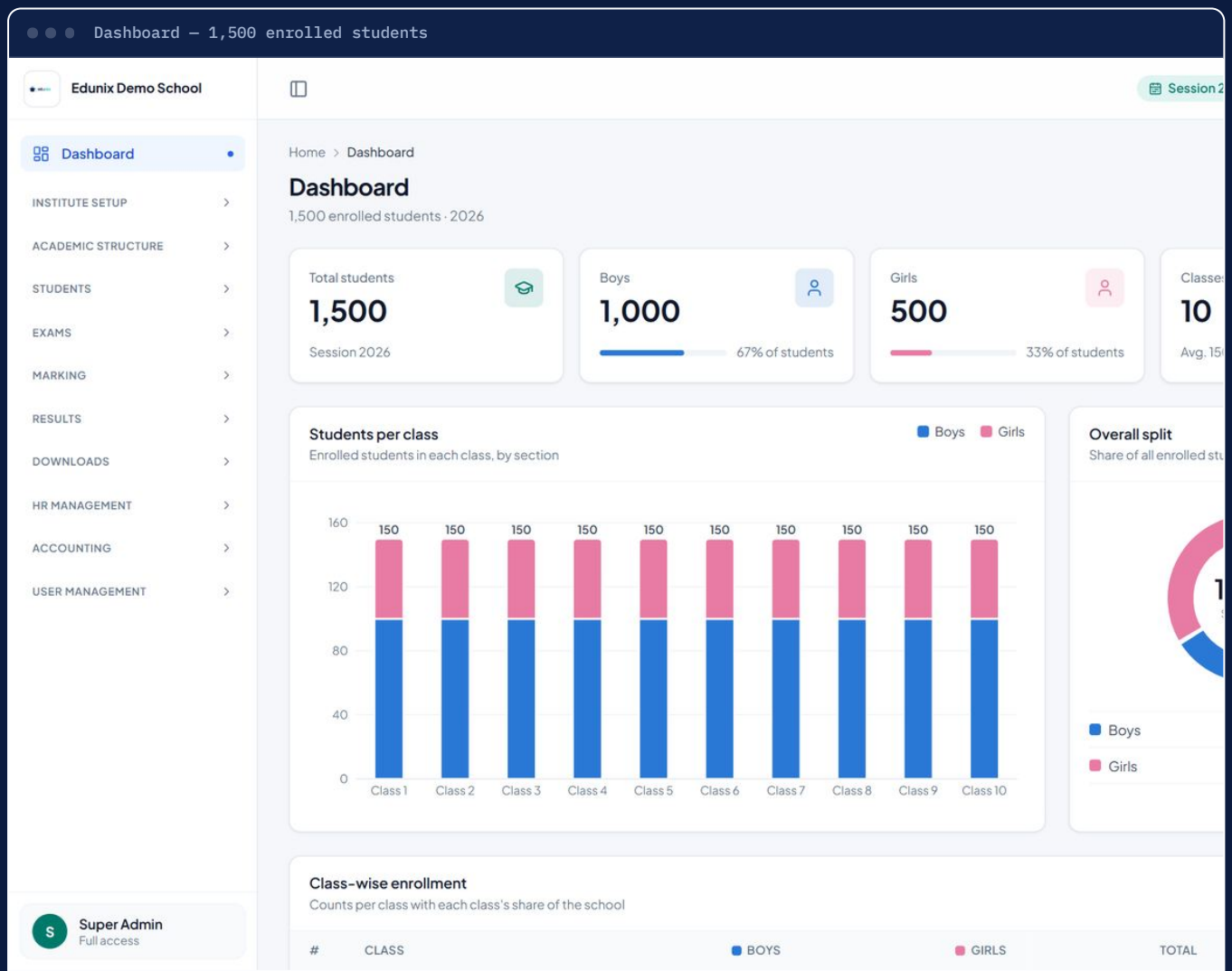

SMS School management

Students and academics

One student record, one enrolment per academic year — so history survives promotion.

- Admission, transfer, archive
- Class routines and exam routines
- Mark entry, results, merit lists

HRM Human resources

Staff and their duties

Teaching and non-teaching staff, with the duties and approvals that go with them.

- Designations and promotion paths
- Leave with multi-step approval
- Period and exam-hall duties

ERP Access & operations

Who can do what

Role-based access over every page, and the daily attendance that runs underneath it.

- View / add / edit / delete per page
- System users and portal access
- Audit log of every change

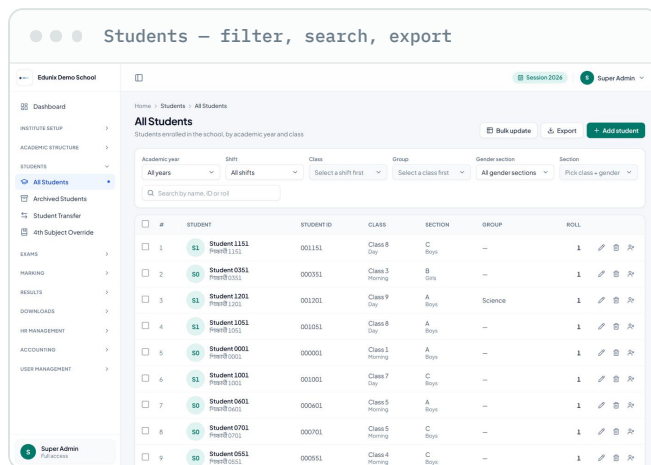
ACC Accounts & finance

Fees that post themselves

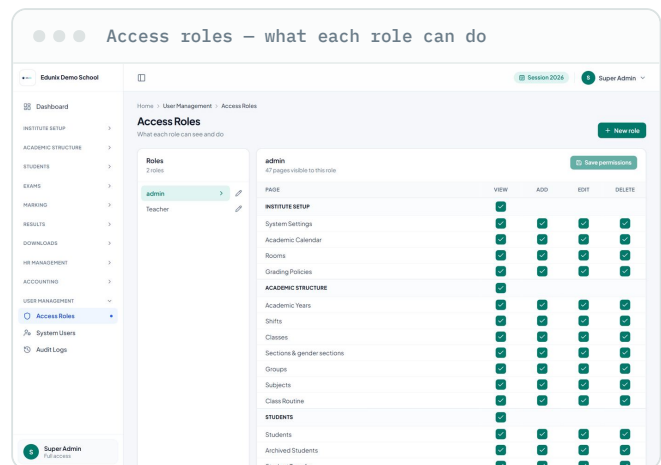
A real double-entry ledger underneath, so collection and reporting agree by construction.

- Monthly invoice generation
- Cash counter and online payment
- Trial balance and balance sheet

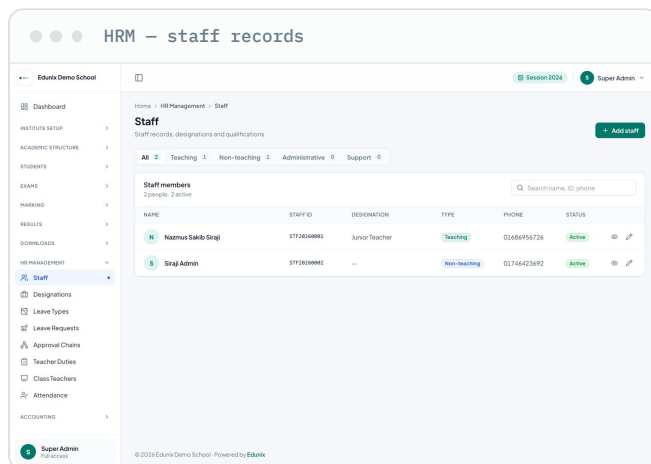
The screens the office works in all day.



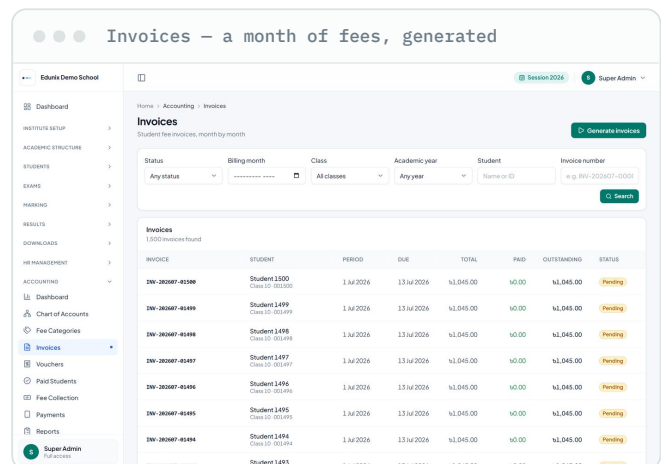
Every enrolment, filtered by year, shift, class, group and section.

A Ramadan routine

A second timetable you set once and switch to, rather than rewriting every period.

Names in both scripts, and Bangla that renders correctly in every printed report.

Admit cards and seat plans

Generated for a class or a roll range, with the exam timetable on the card.

Shifts and gender sections

Morning and Day, Boys and Girls, Science and Commerce — the real shape of a class.

Fees in ট, paid the local way

Invoices and receipts in taka, with online payment through the gateway parents use.

Everyone gets the part that concerns them.

One login each, scoped by role. Nobody sees a page they have no business on — and nobody phones the office for a mark sheet again.

Students & parents

This week's routine, upcoming exams, published results, fee invoices, and paying online.

Teachers

Their own periods and exam duties, their section's attendance, and mark entry for their classes.

Staff

Profile, leave balance, leave requests — and, for approvers, the queue waiting on them.

Administrators

Roles built page by page, with view, add, edit and delete set separately.
